<b>Incident/Emergency Response</b>  Service A	Timely Efficient Safe Effective	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Contractor shall provide equipment and personnel resources necessary to support Safety Service Patrol and Emergency Services Responders for Incident management operations 24 hours-a-day, 7 days-a-week.</li> <li>The Contractor after arriving on site shall report to the Incident Command and provide and support appropriate resources to handle any and all traffic control needs to ensure the safety of the Incident scene and traveling public.</li> <li>The Contractor shall provide timely notification of arrival and departures from all Incidents to the TOC &amp; CHART.</li> </ul> <p><b>Timeliness Requirements:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>On site response during the hours of 06:00 to 18:00 hours, (considered normal business hours) shall be no greater than 30 minutes, once notification or discovery of the Incident.</li> <li>On site response during the hours of 18:00 to 06:00 hours, (after normal business hours) shall be no greater than 60 minutes, once notification or discovery of the Incident.</li> <li>Temporary lane closures shall be installed immediately, or as directed by Incident Command.</li> <li>Traffic detours and diversions if needed shall be installed within 60 minutes, after directed by Incident Command.</li> <li>Long term lane closures (any closures lasting over five (5) hours) if needed shall be installed within 60 minutes after being directed by Incident Command</li> </ul>
